

Importing Fogra 52 and installing for uncoated stocks

1. Save the Supplied ICC Profile

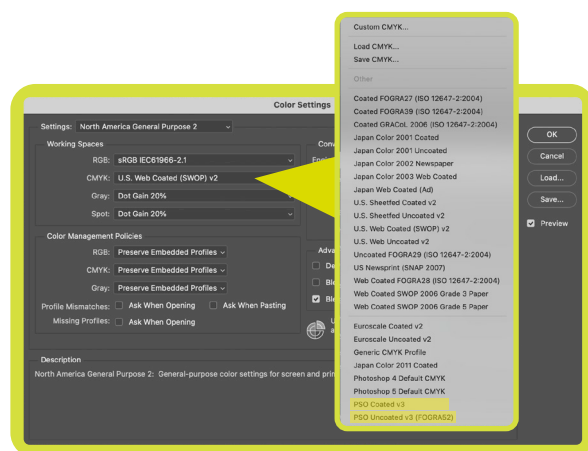
- Download the supplied FOGRA 52 ICC profile (PSO Uncoated v3).
- Save the profile file (.icc or .icm) locally before installation.

2. Install the Profile (Mac)

- Place the profile in: HD → Library → ColorSync → Profiles
- Alternatively, double-click the profile to install via ColorSync Utility.
- Restart Adobe applications after installation.

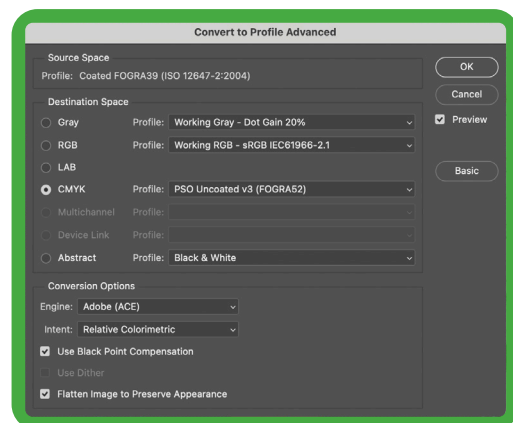
3. Confirm Installation in Adobe

- Open Adobe InDesign or Photoshop.
- Go to Edit → Color Settings.
- Confirm PSO Uncoated v3 (FOGRA52) appears in the CMYK profile list.



4. Converting Images to FOGRA 52

- In Photoshop, use Edit → Convert to Profile.
- Select Destination: PSO Uncoated v3 (FOGRA52).
- Rendering Intent: Relative Colorimetric.
- Enable Black Point Compensation.



5. Using FOGRA 52 in InDesign

- Ensure Working CMYK is set to PSO Uncoated v3 (FOGRA52).
- When exporting PDFs, select Convert to Destination (Preserve Numbers).
- Choose PSO Uncoated v3 (FOGRA52) as the Destination profile.

Important Notes

- All Adobe applications must reference the same installed profile.
- Restart Adobe software if the profile does not appear.
- Avoid embedding conflicting profiles in exported PDFs.
